

## PUPIL PREMIUM 2013/14

### Academic Year 2013/14

At Ravenscroft we had 110 pupils (62.1%) eligible for Pupil Premium in 2013/14 and have been allocated £104,830 (£953 per child).

### Intervention Strategies Introduced

- Extra Teaching Assistant hours to improve outcomes and support pupils in Foundation Stage
- Extra Teaching Assistant hours to improve Writing and Reading outcomes at end of Key Stage 1
- Extra Teaching Assistant hours to improve Writing and Reading outcomes at end of KS1 and KS2, which includes Precision Teaching and small group support
- One to one tuition for Year 6 pupils

### Resources/Services purchased to support pupils

- Purchased Mathletics/Spelldrome to improve independent learning and IT access
- Employ Child Counselling services for vulnerable pupils
- Purchase Volunteer reading support for targeted Year 1 pupils
- Support Holiday Club access for vulnerable pupils
- Emergency fund set up for vulnerable pupils and families
- Spare uniforms/PE kits/clothing for Forest School project purchased
- Transport costs for visits including Year 6 outdoor educational visit
- Performances, projects and visitors to school
- Year 6 Booster materials
- Extra sessions of Educational Psychologist
- Blast, Talk Boost Speech/Language programme for Reception and Key Stage 1 pupils
- Attendance/Behaviour Awards
- Family Learning programme and resources
- Junior Achievement Award in Year 3 and First Aid for Year 5 and Year 6

### Outcomes

The outcomes for FSM pupils are very similar to their classmates. A good percentage of FSM pupils reach Level 4+ in all subjects.
