

## PUPIL PREMIUM 2014/2015

### Academic Year 2014/15

In 2014/15 financial year the Pupil Premium will increase to:

- £1300 for each eligible child
- £1900 for each looked after child

At Ravenscroft we have 113 pupils eligible for Pupil Premium in 2014/15 and have been allocated £146,900.

### Intervention Strategies Introduced

- Extra Teaching Assistant hours to improve outcomes and support FSM/SEND pupils in Foundation Stage
- Extra Teaching Assistant hours to improve Writing and Reading outcomes at end of KS1
- Extra Teaching Assistant hours to improve Writing and Reading outcomes at end of KS1&2 including Precision Teaching and small group support
- Extra Teaching Assistant hours to improve outcomes and support FSM/SEND pupils in Y6
- Specialist Support Teacher for 2.5 days per week to improve outcomes for FSM/SEND pupils Y1–Y6

### Resources/Services purchased to support pupils

- Purchase mathematics/spelldrome to improve independent learning and IT access for FSM
- Child Counselling for 3 vulnerable pupils all FSM
- Support Holiday club access for vulnerable pupil
- Purchase Volunteer reading support for targeted Y1 pupils
- Purchase spare uniform/PE kits
- Support transport (FSM children) for trips
- Performances and visitors
- Pay for most vulnerable children for Outdoor Ed visit/transport
- Y6 Booster materials
- 1:1 tuition
- Extra Educational Psychologist time
- A Chance to Talk Speech/Language programme for R and KS1 pupils
- Attendance/Behaviour Awards
- Family Learning programmes
- Family Learning Resources
- Junior Achievement Award Y3 and First Aid Y5/6
- Mayors Award Y5 pupils

- Set up an emergency fund for vulnerable pupils and families

#### **Outcomes 2014**

The outcomes for FSM pupils are usually very similar to their classmates. A good percentage of FSM pupils reach Level 4+ in all subjects, although this cohort contained a large number of SA+ pupils on FSM.
