

## **PUPIL PREMIUM 2015/2016**

### **Academic Year 2015/16**

In 2015/16 financial year the Pupil Premium is £1320 for each eligible child.

At Ravenscroft we have 114 eligible for Pupil Premium - the school has been allocated £150,780.

Pupil Premium funding received will be used for TA and SEND Specialist Support Teacher support across the whole school for vulnerable and targeted pupils in Foundation, KS1 and across KS2, for one to one tuition in Year 6, Volunteer Reading support (KS1), visits/visitors and additional resources for FSM/Vulnerable pupils.

### **Intervention Strategies introduced**

- Extra teaching assistant hours to improve outcomes and support FSM/SEND pupils in Foundation Stage
- Extra teaching assistant hours to improve writing and reading outcomes at end of KS1
- Extra teaching assistant hours to improve writing and reading outcomes at end of KS1 & KS2 including precision teaching and small group support
- Extra teaching assistant hours to improve outcome and support FSM/SEND pupils in Year 6
- Specialist Support Teaching to improve outcomes for FSM/SEND pupils Year 1 -6
