Spelling lists will be given out on Monday to learn for Friday.

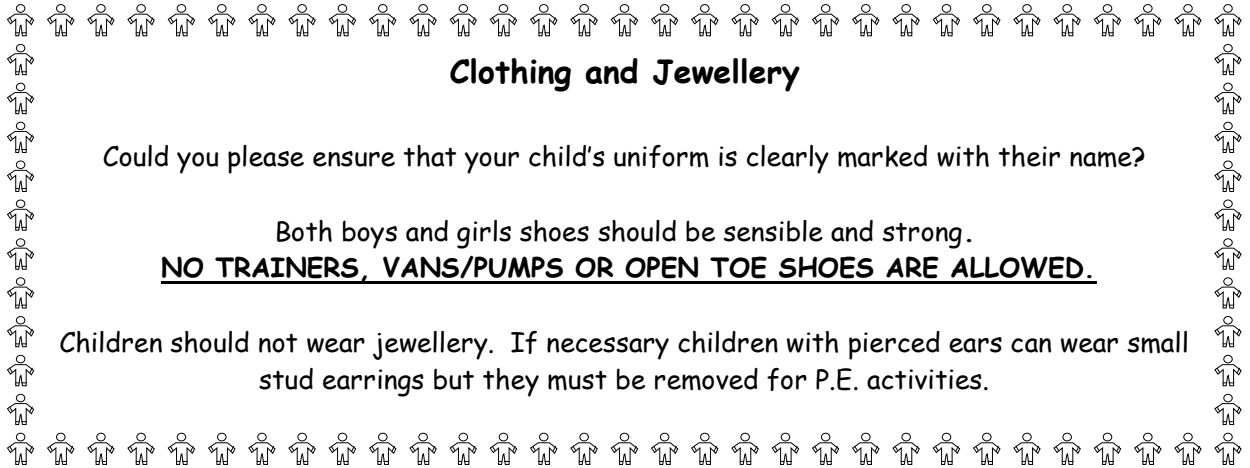

Snack

All KS2 children will be offered a fruit snack. Snack will be £1 per week.

KS1 children receive free fruit each day and are therefore not required to make any payment.



Clothing and Jewellery

Could you please ensure that your child's uniform is clearly marked with their name?

Both boys and girls shoes should be sensible and strong.

NO TRAINERS, VANS/PUMPS OR OPEN TOE SHOES ARE ALLOWED.

Children should not wear jewellery. If necessary children with pierced ears can wear small stud earrings but they must be removed for P.E. activities.

School Reception/Office Procedures

We want to make the children's arrival to school as easy and safe as possible and also ease congestion at the front entrance to our school at what can be one of the busiest times of the day.

To help keep the office clear if you are sending money into school, please send it with your child to his /her class in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, the amount of money it contains and what the money is for e.g. dinner money, trip money etc.. Any change will be sent home in an envelope with your child at the end of the school day.

DONT FORGET, ALL KEY STAGE 1 CHILDREN (Y1 and Y2) ARE ENTITLED TO A FREE SCHOOL MEAL.

We are aware that sometimes letters can be mislaid and therefore there will be copies of any recent letters sent home with your child available if you need one, these can be collected from the reception area of school; as can envelopes if you require them. Copies of letters will also be available on the school website.

We hope that these arrangements will make the start to the day as pleasant and safe as possible for all parents, children and staff.
