

Ravenscroft Parent Protocols Covid-19

1. If your child has a temperature do not send them in and ring the school office.
2. If your child has a cough, do not send them in and ring the school office.
3. Please ensure every evening you go through social distancing guidelines with your child.
4. Where possible only drop-off and collect members living in your household or that you are bubbled with and do not car share with other families.
5. If you are running late and miss drop-off slot, please go to the Main office where you will be required to wait outside until there is appropriate staffing to allow your child to enter.
6. Please call the school office for assistance 0151 477 8290.
7. The school office will not be able to accept late packed lunches or other equipment.
8. Each child must bring their own clearly labelled water bottle.
9. Limit items brought in to school to: water bottle, packed lunch in a disposable bag, PE kit (cleaned after each use) . Please only send coats in on colder days. Do not bring in pencils: pencil cases, books/work completed at home or other school bags.
10. Please ensure your child washes their hands before leaving the house with soap and water.
11. Please talk to your child about social distancing and the importance of hand washing.
12. On arrival at school please only drop-off at your designated year groups area. If you have children at different drop-off zones, please use the earliest drop-off.
13. Please social distance with all other parents. This is important for your health and safety and it models social distancing to your children.
14. Children will be doing regular PE sessions – so a PE kit needs to come in. This will be sent home after each use and must be washed including the PE bag.
15. If packed lunch, please have a chat to your child about not sharing their food, for example crisps. If possible send lunch in disposable bag that can be thrown away once lunch has finished.
16. At pick up and drop off please use 1 way system and follow the blue path and model social distancing at all times.
17. There will be signs and markings in and around the school encouraging social distancing – if you see these please follow them and use them to educate your children.
18. If we are expecting a child in and they are unwell you must still follow same absence procedures as normal – let the school office know by 10am at the latest.
19. If your child does develop symptoms please order a test and once received, provide proof of result to school.
20. Parents not following protocols will be challenged. This is to ensure the school can remain operational and for the health and safety of all.
