Dear Parents/Carers,

If your child is unwell we need to know so please call us or use the school APP.

What symptoms should I be concerned about?

You should look for any of the following symptoms:

- new continuous cough
- fever (a temperature of 37.8°C or higher)
- loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

If your child develops these symptoms, however mild, at any point

They need to isolate, which includes staying off school. You can arrange for your child to be tested via NHS UK or by contacting NHS 119 via telephone if you do not have internet access.

If the test is positive, your child would need to self-isolate for 10 days from the date of onset of symptoms. The rest of the household would not need to self isolate but it would be recommended that they also get tested.
