The sunflower has been Ukraine's national flower for a long time, but it has swiftly become a worldwide symbol of solidarity for the country and its people since the Russian invasion began.

The children are creating their own sunflower which they will bring home. You can display this in your window or anywhere else you feel appropriate.

We are creating a window display of sunflowers in the town centre in the old Pound Bakery store on St Chad's parade.

We are also discussing the war with children and answering their questions and concerns about what they see on the news. For many of our children this is their first experience of observing war.
