Children can come to school dressed as a character from a story book. (no football kits please). If children do not want to dress up please wear school uniform.

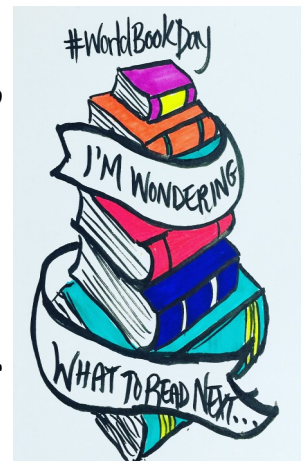
Have fun deciding who you would like to be for the day.
