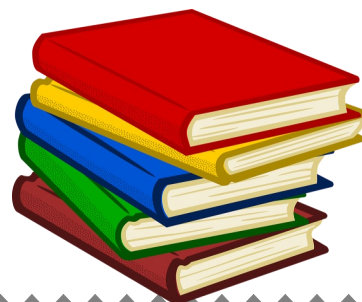
CHILDREN'S BOOK SWAP
