School Uniform List

Grey skirt or pinafore

Summer – Red and white checked school dresses

Winter – White blouse or polo shirt, trousers can be worn in the Winter

All children's shoes should be sensible, strong, and black. No open toe shoes, converse or trainers are allowed.

Jewellery

Children should not wear jewellery. If necessary, children with pierced ears can wear small stud earrings but they must be removed for P.E activities.

Hair Styles

We expect our pupils to wear their hair in a way that is both suitable for school and appropriate for a primary age child. For health and safety reasons we require pupils with long hair to tie it back when in school.
