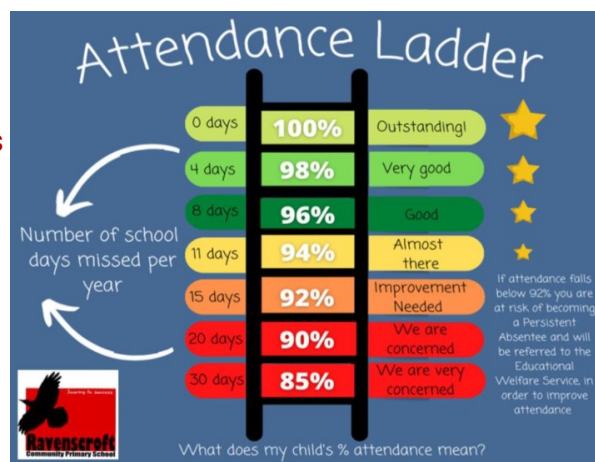
Good Attendance: Be in the 'Green'

Here at Ravenscroft Community Primary, attendance is a high priority. There are links between good attendance and good attainment and the opposite is true; poor attendance can lead to poor attainment.

Attendance is also linked to safeguarding; if your child is not in school we need to check they are safe and well.

We regularly review your child's attendance and where there is concern we will get in touch. We have a graduated response that means we will make calls, offer support, send letters, invite you to meetings and may make referrals to the Education Welfare Service (EWS).

We have a good relationship with Knowsley Council and work together to ensure as many children as possible are in school every day.
