As you can see from the image above, our attendance is not good, across the whole school.

Our highest attending class is 92.5% (Year 3), which is well below our school expectation and the Local Authority and National expectation. In fact, across the 50 Knowsley Primary Schools, our attendance is one of the lowest.

In Knowsley, schools and the local authority are urging families and pupils to aim for **97% attendance.**

Attendina every day aives children the best chance to learn. develop skills, make friends and succeed later in life. Regular attendance is linked to better outcomes in reading, writing and maths, and even a small amount of absence can leave gaps in learning that are hard to catch up on. Here in Knowsley, too many pupils are still missing too much school, with large proportion persistently absent from lessons - a challenge the council and schools are working together to address.







Holiday Dates 2026 - 2027

We appreciate how expensive holidays can be for families. With this in mind, we would encourage parents and carers to consider booking holidays during the second week of the Summer half term break (Week Beginning 31st May 2027), rather than taking children out of school during term time.

This week falls outside the holiday period for many other schools, meaning **flights and holidays are usually significantly cheaper**. Planning ahead for this week can help families enjoy valuable time together while avoiding peak prices, unauthorised absence, and disruption to learning.
